

SUGGESTED METHODS FOR CONTACTING NORTHAMPTONSHIRE POLICE

Please never be afraid to contact your local Police. Never think you are 'bothering' them. Also never assume someone else will 'probably' report a matter and therefore leave it. Your Police are here to serve their community and are keen to engage.

You will only get the service you deserve if you interact with local Officers and keep them informed of issues and matters of interest in your area. The less that is formally reported inevitably leads to less patrols and attention to the area, as it will be deemed that all is well in the Community and therefore it does not require assistance or any degree of scrutiny.

Formally reporting matters of concern can also have impact on issues such as Planning Applications as research will be done into matters such as Crime figures and Anti-Social incidents.

In case of Emergency - 999

Non- Emergency matters, but in need of prompt action - 101

(These calls will be 'triaged' by call handlers to determine how best dealt with)

The following matters can be reported **online** (unless requiring prompt action) at www.northants.police.uk Northants Police are very keen for this facility to be used more than at present.

- Crime reporting
- Anti-social behaviour
- Lost or Stolen Vehicles
- Road Traffic collisions (Non-Injury)
- Missing Persons
- Civil Disputes
- Covid breaches

At this time there is no provision for reporting **Suspicious Activity**. Suggest reporting such matters via **101** if happening at the time or if less urgent, email our local Neighbourhood Policing Team on
