

Statement from Noel Rogers, Cottingham resident and Walk Leader for East Carlton Health Walking Group

“As a local group, with a current membership of 115, we regularly have 40-50 people walking twice a week along the Jurassic Way from Cottingham to Middleton passing the proposed development site. We have people travelling from many of our neighbouring towns and villages including Corby, Kettering and Market Harborough, and some from as far afield as Northampton, just to enjoy the tranquillity and beauty of this walk which is on our very own doorstep.
